The Initial Boot Camp for the 2^{nd} cohort of the MBA in Impact Entrepreneurship program students was held from December 03 – 09, 2018 at the School of Graduate Studies, St. Mary's University.



Bradley Googins (Professor), a Visiting Professor of Strategy and Senior Fellow of the E4Impact Foundation at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Milan, teaming up with Simon Tarekegn (Assistant Professor), an Accounting instructor at SMU, taught students business strategy and Accounting for Entrepreneurs after which students made presentations on their projects. The Boot Camp was brought to an end by competitions in three areas – Best Business Idea, Best Start Up and Best Scale Up. Students received feedback by the jury at the end of their presentations, which they said helped them see their projects from different perspectives. SMU is grateful for the invaluable contributions of the judges in helping students reshape their projects.

Research and Development

A Public Lecture Held



he Research and Knowledge Management Office of St. Mary's University organized a public lecture on 22nd November 2018 at Main Campus. The public lecture was given by Dr. Samuel Tefera, Assistant Professor and Asian Desk Coordinator at the Center for African and Oriental Studies, Associate Dean for Research and Technology Transfer, College of Social Sciences, Addis Ababa University.



Dr. Samuel's presentation explored, "The Commune Program and Development Challenges of Pastoral Areas in Ethiopia." It focused on policies and development interventions in the pastoral and agro-pastoral areas of Ethiopia and particularly emphasized on the resettlement programs that aimed at the decentralization of resources and quality service delivery.

The presentation was accompanied by a short documentary film, which was produced based on Dr. Samuel's study on the Hammer tribe's marriage ceremony, by National Geographic. In the documentary film, Dr. Samuel was a guide and an interpreter of the event to one of the famous international actors, Morgan Freeman.



Following the presentation and video show, there was a discussion session where many issues were raised by the participants on which the lecturer reflected his study's

findings. This initiated a promising future – a possibility for partnership between SMU and the College of Social Sciences of Addis Ababa University.

Partnership, Outreach and Community Services

St. Mary's Participated in a National Conference

nation-wide Labour Conference under the theme, "Industrial Peace for Inclusive and Sustainable Development", was held on 26-27 December 2018 at UN-ECA Conference Center, Addis Ababa. The conference was aimed at looking into the development of Decent Work across the nation through brawny cooperation of tripartite (Government-Employer-Employee) and social dialogue which are later supposed to support the attainment of the theme. Speakers in the opening ceremony were H.E. Ato Demeke Mekonnen, Deputy Prime Minster of Ethiopia; Ergoge Tesfaye(PhD), Minister, Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (MoLSA); W/ro Kidist Chala, ILO representative to Ethiopia; Getahun Hussein (Engineer), President of Ethiopian Employers' Confederation(EEC); Ato Tadele Yimer, President of Ethiopian Industry Sector Employers' Confederation(EISEC); and Ato Kassahun Folo, President, Confederation of the Ethiopian Trade Union(CETU). Ato Fitsum Arega, Head, Ethiopian Investment Commission and W/ro Yalem Tsegay, Minster, Ministry of Women, Children and Youth Affairs joined the conference during the plenary session.

In his opening remarks, H.E. Ato Demeke Mekonnen warmly acknowledged the immense contributions of employers and employees towards the continuous development of the nation exhibited so far. Appreciating the commitment demonstrated toward the attainment of obligations, Ato Demeke promised that the government will support initiatives on enhancement and sustainable development of Decent Work in the nation.

During the deliberations, some of the major challenges of Decent Work across the nation were identified, which included: absence of labour unions at majority of employers; lack of readiness and enforcement in maintaining Occupational Health and Safety; disparity of policies and laws towards employees of public and private organizations; lack of minimum wage scale/standard; pay and benefit disparity; and emergence of higher number of incompetent and undisciplined labour force.

In her closing remarks, Ergoge Tesfaye(PhD), Minster of MoLSA, confirmed that the conference enabled to sort out practical issues and results of deliberations would be cascaded to concerned stakeholders nationwide to deliberate on the way forward. Long, medium and short-term strategies on such critical issues will be formulated and bestowed to all participants to work hard towards enhancing Decent Work, sustainable peace and development of the nation, she added.

More than 3,000 participants from HR Administration, Labour Unions, employers, universities, House of People's Representatives, regional government representatives and other pertinent stakeholders were in attendance. SMU, represented by the Head of HRM Office, made active participation and voiced its concern over some issues stated in the labour law.

St. Mary's Attended a Workshop

St. Mary's University attended a day-long meeting organized by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education (MoSHE) which was held on December 21, 2018 to launch several softwares developed to automate many of the Ministry's services to make its services paperless. In her opening remarks, Dr Hirut Woldemariam, Minister for MoSHE, stated that among the activities planned to be achieved in 100 days since her assumption of the post is automating the Ministry's services to provide transparent, trustworthy, and efficient services and keep the academic community connected to the world by using ICT. To this effect, ten softwares (applications) have been developed. Following her remarks, Ato Zelalem Assefa, Director for Ethiopian Education and Research Network (EthERNet), introduced all the applications.

The National Academic Digital Repository of Ethiopia (NADRE), which is intended to host and share with institutional repositories of public and private higher education institutions, was launched by the Minister after the briefing. NADRE is said to host publications of different categories including research output, power point presentations, data sets, images, audio and video recordings, posters, theses and dissertations. NADRE has been recognized by the Global Research Network and is allowed to issue Digital Object Identifier (DOI) to research pieces to be published in Ethiopia.

The EthERNet has connected 36 public universities to date and is working toward connecting the 4th generation universities. The Data Collection and Processing Portal (**kpm**-) will be used to collect data from HEIs and compile and share them with relevant bodies online. The Ministry, therefore, requires that each HEI submits its data using this portal.

Professor Afework Kassu, State Minister for MoSHE, called for immediate action and progress report. Promising that such awareness raising meetings will take place in the future on a regular basis, he closed the session by an Amharic adage, "ለውጤት እንገለተ."

In attendance were research vice presidents and librarians of public and private universities. SMU was represented by the librarian and the Executive Assistant to the President(EAP).

SMU Participation in a Review Session

St. Mary's University, represented by its Executive Assistant to the President(EAP), took part in a document review session organized by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education(MoSHE) on December 13 and 14, 2018. Being a member of the Task Force, SMU participated in the review session of the draft Directive on Research and Community Services as per the comments given by stakeholders during a day-long meeting held two weeks before this session. The Directive Development Committee finalized the Directive, which is supposed to be shared with the Legal Department of the Ministry to ensure that it is legally sound and correct. It will, then, be endorsed by the relevant officials of the Ministry after which it will be disseminated to all HEIs.

Visit to Gergesenon Association



The Student Support Services Office, SMU, organized a charity visit under the motto, "**k7£ PATT**? **AUTIL**" with students and staff of SMU on December 8, 2018. The visit was made in response to Her Excellency Dr Hirut Woldemariam's, Minister, Ministry of Science and Higher Education, request intended to strengthen volun-

tary activities and the culture of humanitarian engagement of the SMU community. During the visit, a total of 20 volunteers participated and used cloths estimated around Birr. 11,000.00 (Eleven Thousand Birr) were donated.



St. Mary's Took Part in MoSHE's Meeting

St. Mary's took part in a meeting organized by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education (MoSHE) on November 30, 2018 to reestablish the Higher Education National Research and Community Service Council, enrich a draft document on Directive for Research and Community Services, and declare standards for science laboratories and workshops.

Following the opening remarks made by Professor Afework Kassu, State Minister for MoSHE, draft documents were presented on Directive for Research and Community Services, Standards for Science Workshop and Laboratories and revised guidelines for the reestablishment of Higher Education National Research and Community Service Council. Appreciating the Ministry's efforts, participants gave feedback on all the documents presented. After thorough deliberations, the Higher Education National Research and Community Service Council was formally reestablished with participants' signatures. Members of the Council include all public and private universities and some government offices. The Council shall meet every three months.

In his last statement, Professor Afework requested participants to suggest potential scholars and professionals who could serve the Ministry as members of the Think Tank to be put in place soon. In attendance were academic and research vice presidents of all public universities, representatives from some government offices and the four private universities. SMU was represented by the Executive Assistant to the President in lieu of the Director for Research and Knowledge Management Office.

SMU Participation in a Workshop

St. Mary's participated in a workshop on "Ethiopia dialogue event on enabling equitable research systems: A meeting of minds for action" organized by the Ethiopian Academy of Sciences (EAS) and International Network for the Availablity of Scientific Publications (INASP) from 22 - 24, November 2018 at Intercontinental Addis Hotel in Addis Ababa. The purpose of the workshop was to look into ways equitable research system which contributes to the development of Ethiopia could be put in place.

To this end, deliberations were made classified into different panels to 1) define a shared vision for the holistic, equitable, collaborative and sustainable research system in the country, 2) articulate enablers and key challenges that limit equitable access to and use of full contribution by researchers and institutions to the national research and development agenda, and 3) list out possible solutions for overcoming the challenges.

The key issues on which the deliberations focused included the status and role of the Ethiopian Education and Research Network known as "EthERNet", gender inequity in higher education and research, and inequities in international collaboration. The workshop was brought to an end with a communiqué of recommendations which envisioned Ethiopia's equitable research system.

It was agreed that the EAS and INASP shall send the draft communiqué to the workshop participants for feedback after which the recommendations shall be reported to the Ministry of Technology and Innovation to which the EAS is accountable. Then deliberations shall be made with the pertinent government bodies for the realization of the recommendations. To this effect, "champions" who could be instrumental in advocating the realization of this nation-wide vision were identified. A list which identified potential stakeholders which should have participated in this workshop but were not present and those which need to be consulted in the development of the final document was also produced for future use.

In attendance were representatives from some public universities, a professional association, civic societies, a development partner, and research institutes. St. Mary's University, which was represented by the Executive Assistant to the President, was the only private university which attended the workshop.

VCT Session Held

the Student Support Services Office(SSSO) of St. Mary's University in collaboration with AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF) Ethiopia, a Non Governmental Organization based in Addis Ababa, held Voluntary Counseling and Testing(VCT) on December 6-7, 2018. The event was organized in connection with the World AIDS Day, which is marked on the 1st of December every year. 32 volunteer students and staff of the university participated at the event.

SMU Library Received Books

St. Mary's University Library has been partnering with the Ethiopian National Archives and Library Agency for many years. In connection with this, the Ethiopian National Archives and Library Agency donated 240 books with different titles to St. Mary's library. Invited by the Agency, the Chief librarian of St. Mary's University collected the books on October 12, 2018. SMU is highly grateful for the donation and extends its thanks to the Agency.
